___ "Robo Mania!" Lego fun and electronics, from humanoids to robogators

___ "Let's SPRK the imagination with Coding and Robotics!" Students will take a hands-on approach to interactive learning by exploring and creating codes for the Sphero SPRK.

___ CSI - Calling all crime scene investigators. If you have ever played clue then this class is for you. Students will be solving a case of "Whodunit?" while exploring how to read and take fingerprints, bullet trajectory, forensic entomology and ink chromatography. In a scavenger hunt like fashion, students will collect clues and solve the mystery of what happened to Mr. Excedrin.

___ Riddle Me This! Students collaborate to decipher codes and riddles, problem-solve, and untangle brain-baffling puzzles.

___ Eco-Explorers! Students will conduct water and wildlife investigations to learn more about the natural world. From water Olympics to earthworm experiments and habitat hunts, students will have hands-on fun while learning to be eco-explorers in today's modern world.

___ Escape This! Do you enjoy challenges? Do you like puzzles? Can you handle the pressure? This session is for those who want to have fun playing games that teach critical thinking, teamwork, and complex and creative problem solving. We'll work with a collection of locks, hidden contraptions, timers, keys, and other "diversion hardware" to play ultra-engaging Breakout games. Sometimes competitive, sometimes cooperative – always fun! Join us!

___ "Chem4kids" Enter the professor's laboratory to experience icky, bubbling, slimy, gooey, hands-on science experiences for the "young chemist".

Participants will discover the world of matter, its physical and chemical properties, and the "boom-bang" effect of chemical reactions!
